

# FAMILY WORSHIP GUIDE

Read:  
2 Samuel 6:1-23

Say this:

1. David's desire for the ark expressed his desire for the manifest presence of God. This man after God's own heart purposed to put the ark of the Lord in the place of preeminence it deserved. He had nothing but the glory of the Lord in mind. But tragically, he was taken away with the fervency of his zeal. His desire was good and his motives pure, but he displeased the Lord he sought to honor. It is not sufficient to claim a worthy purpose without conforming as well to the clear mandates of God's Word. He adopted the practice of the pagans in transporting the ark (1 Sam. 6) in violation of the precise method that God had prescribed. Methods of worship do matter, and we must avoid adopting or adapting the practices of the world for use in sacred worship. There are many Christians who desire the right things but are lax in the mode of practice. Not only is God the sole object of worship, but He has revealed the acceptable way of worshipping.
